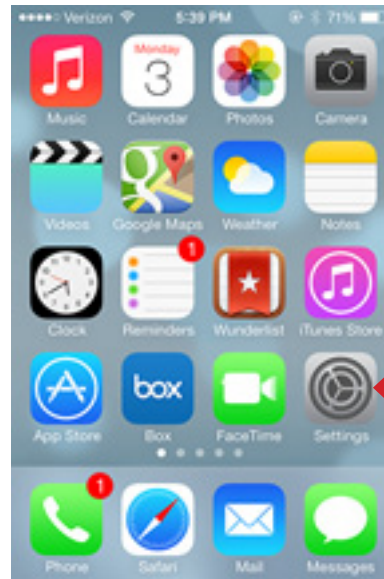

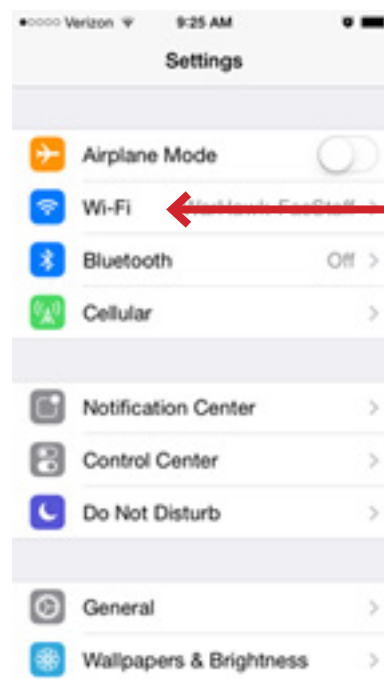

Wi-Fi Set-up >> Apple iPhone®

1. Start by tapping on your **Settings** app.



2. Tap on **Wi-Fi** and then ensure that Wi-Fi is enabled. If it is not, please switch it to **On**.

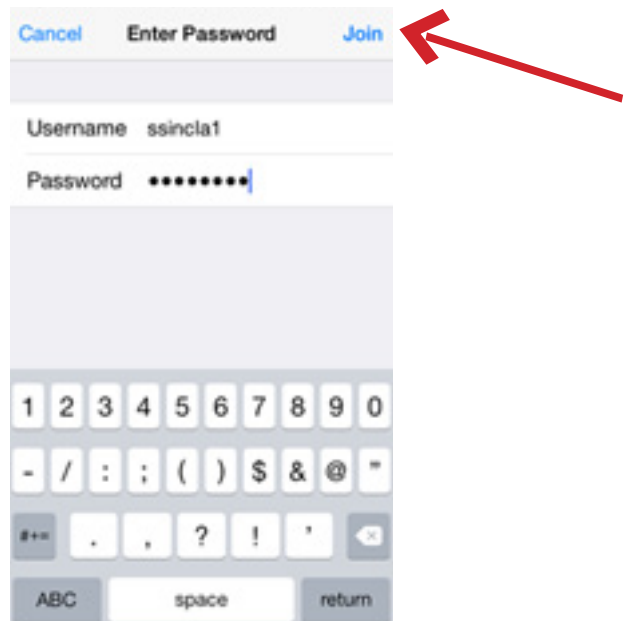


3. Then select the SSID you want to connect to. In this example, we will be connecting to **WarHawk-Wifi**.

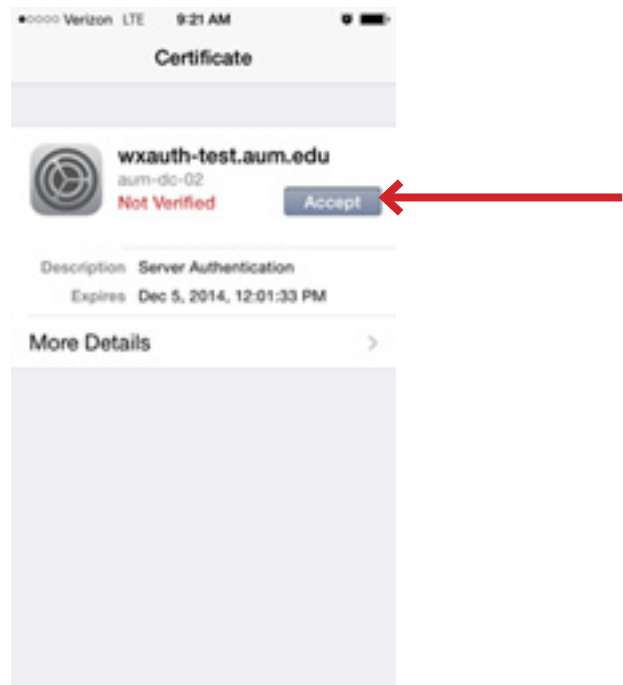


4. Next, type in your AUM username and password.

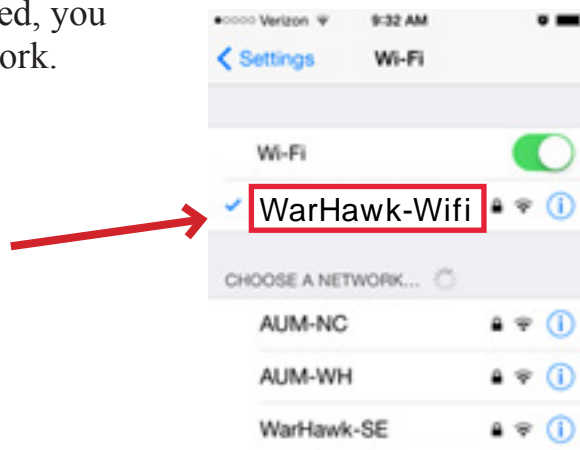
Then, tap Join.



5. **Accept** the certificate being presented.



6. After your credentials are verified, you will then be connected to the network.



-Please note:

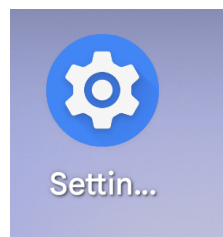
If you get a message stating that you are “unable to connect to the network”, tap **Dismiss**, then **Accept the certificate again**. *This may happen several times.

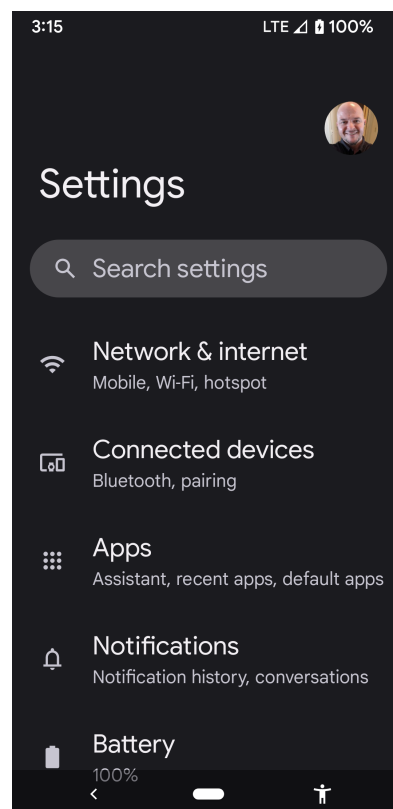

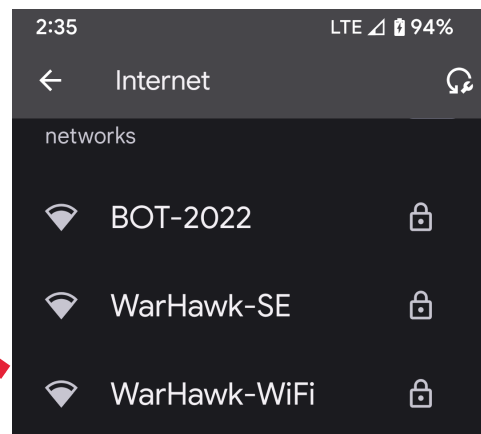
1. From your home screen, tap the **Settings** icon.



2. Choose the **Network & internet** option and then tap **internet**.

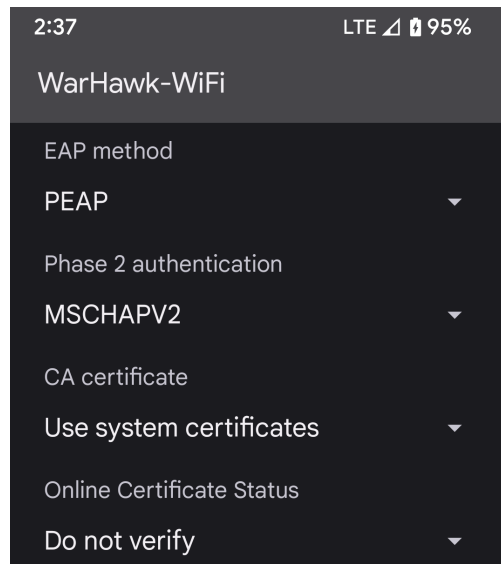


3. Select the SS ID you are wanting to connect to. In this example, we will be connecting to **WarHawk-Wifi**.



4. Make sure your settings match the following:

- EAP Method: PEAP
- Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPV2
- CA Certificate: Use System Certificates
- Online Certificate Status: Do Not Verify



5. If prompted for Domain, type in aum.edu


Next, enter your AUM Username into the “Identity” field and your password in the “Wireless password” field.

*Leave the “Anonymous identity” field blank.

Note: When typing your AUM username, do not include @aum.edu

6. Then, **Connect**.

7. You should then see Connected under the “WarHawk-Wifi” network once you have successfully connected.
